This Week

This week the children have been enjoying playing 'birthdays'. We have followed the children's interests enhancing our provision with: chocolate playdough, bun cases, cake decorations, candles, party hats, birthday banners and balloons. The children have been planning and creating their own parties. In the water tray they have filled different sized bottles and cups with 'pink lemonade' for the party.

They have also been threading beads to make bracelets, making leaf collages and print painting using different utensils.

Outside the children have been making different vehicles using large cardboard boxes.

In forest school, the children have been reading the story 'Room on the Broom'. They had to find different objects and they created a potion to ring the witch's broom back. They also challenged themselves learning how to use the ladder rope.

Our parent governor, Kirsten Knight, attended Forest School as part of her governor visit.

The 2 year olds have created a car wash outside and have enjoyed washing the vehicles. They have also enjoyed playing in the tent.

The children also follow their own lines of enquiry e.g. making models, playing super heroes, creating pictures, making cards in all different areas of nursery. We encourage the children to take the lead in their learning.
