<u>This Week</u>

Sunflower Room (3-4years)

This week we are continuing to learn about Traditional Tales. Some of the activities include: re-enacting the story of The Three Little Pigs, dying string with paint to make a rainbow, colour mixing, colour mixing with water outside, name writing and gardening.

Rainbow Room (2-3 years)

This week the children are learning about The Three Little Pigs. Some of the activities include: learning words from the story, matching pictures, sorting objects by colour and gardening.
