This week we are having a storytelling week, where members of staff will rotate around the different Key Person groups to read them a story. The children will have a daily story by a different adult.

<u>This Week</u>

Sunflower Room (3-4years)

This week the children are continuing to learn about Spring and Traditional Tales. Some of the activities include: spotting signs of spring and talking about what they have observed, making and tasting porridge, favourite book survey, making slime and exploring with porridge oats.

Some of the activities include: sticking hair on Goldilocks, making and tasting porridge, role play, reenacting the story, matching big, small and medium objects and exploring with porridge oats. **Focus story**: Goldilocks and the Three Bears

Focus Song: Miss Polly Had a Dolly

Forest School: Gruffalo hunt - following clues and pictures.

Focus Number Song: When Goldilocks Went to the House of the Bears

PSED: family photos - please remember to add family photos onto Tapestry.

Physical: learning to stop and go and stop at an obstacle.

Makaton Sign: daddy - see above
