Sunflower Room (3-4years)

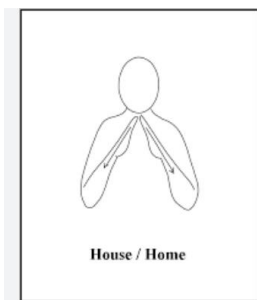
